

Premier League – variation to Junior Domestic competition

Player Eligibility & Points

- **No Points Restrictions** apply within the Premier League.
 - Players will **not carry representative points** into this competition.
 - The *Junior Representative Players Points System Guidelines* will not apply to Premier League teams.
- Players are permitted to play **two games in the same age group on the same day** (one Premier League and one Saturday Domestic).
 - **Premier League** (no points restrictions), and
 - **Saturday Domestic A–F Grade** (where the current points system applies).

Permits & Import Players

Permits

- A permit is required where a player participates in the Premier League for a different Casey Domestic club/team than their Saturday Domestic club/team.
- A player competing under permit:
 - Is **not classified as an import**, and
 - Must continue to play Saturday Domestic (A–F Grade) with the club/team they were registered to in the previous season.

Import Player Definition

- An *import player* is defined as a player who was registered with a Casey Domestic club/team in the previous season and transfers to a different Casey Domestic club/team to compete in the Premier League.

Import Restrictions

- Each club/team is permitted a maximum of:
 - **Two (2) import players per age group, per gender, per season.**

Players from outside the Casey Basketball Association are **not** considered imports.

Competition Structure

- **Opt-in competition** (no grading process).
